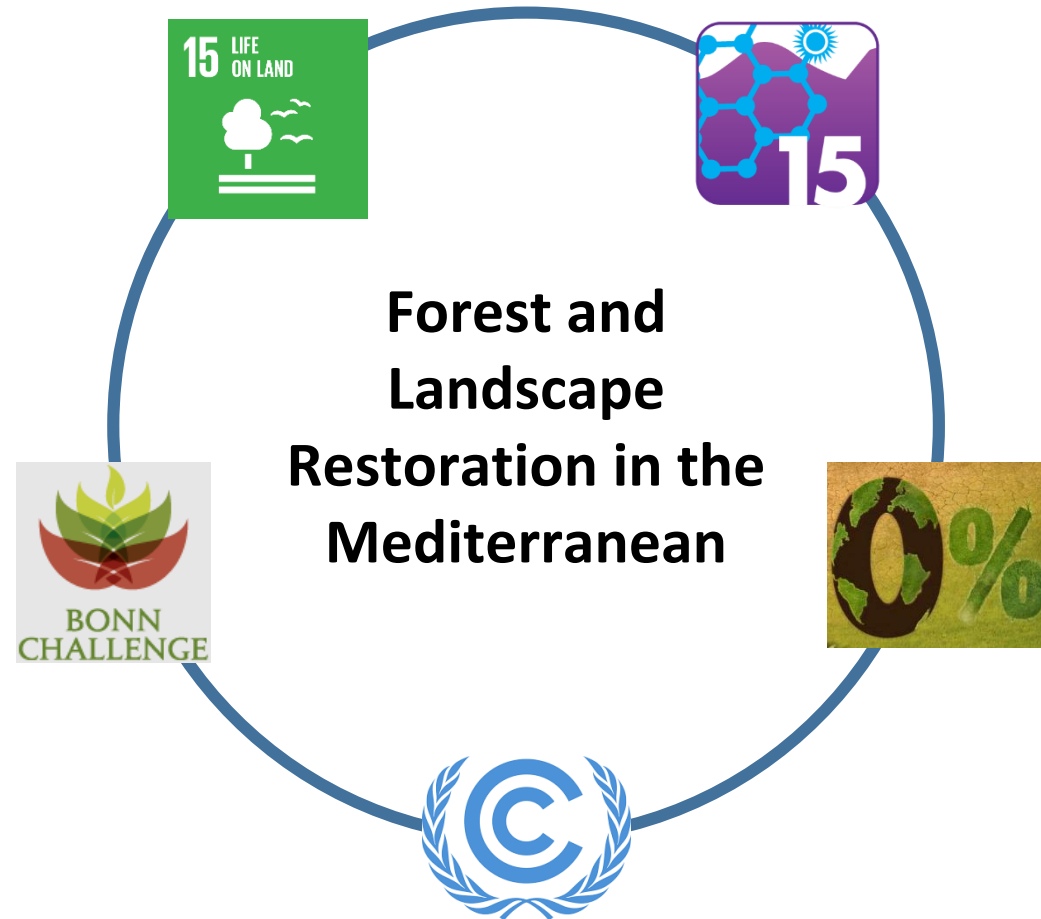

# Objectives

## 2. To reinforce regional cooperation on FLR and Land Degradation Neutrality

- Expand the cooperation to the Sahel
- Promote the contribution of Mediterranean forests to mitigation and adaptation to CC
- Implement the FAO Guidelines
- Implement the CBD Short Term Action Plan for Ecosystem Restoration
- Promote efficient FLR technical recommendations



# Objectives

## **3. To cooperate among interested partners to develop a consensual and diversified strategy for the financing of FLR efforts and reinforce national capacities**

- Support access to climate finance instruments
- Develop a portfolio of LDN Funds projects
- Promote public-private partnerships
- Support to get tools for capacity building



# Objectives

## **4. To assess our respective efforts through the establishment of a voluntary monitoring and notification system for FLR and LDN efforts**

- Approaches, tools and indicators proposed by FLR monitoring experts
- Promote the use of regional information
- Consolidate acquired experiences
